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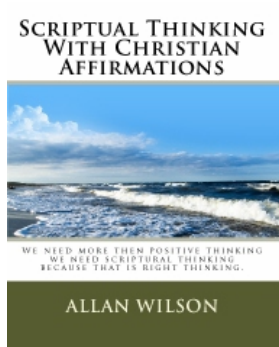

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What about Doctors?



I feel it is important to mention right at the beginning of this book that I highly recommend you visit a Doctor if you have an illness. Believing and trusting that Jesus will heal you is not at odds with visiting a Doctor. In fact it is only by going to a Doctor that many of the marvelous healing testimonies are known. How do you know you were healed of cancer, etc. if you were never diagnosed?



Some Christians believe you are showing a lack of faith if you visit a Doctor. I highly dispute that statement.

I have heard such dangerous statements for people suffering depression that they are showing a lack of faith if they take medication. Depression is a very serious illness and attacks the most vital part of your body – the mind. The same people who make such statements think nothing about taking headache tablets yet for something as serious as depression they look down upon drugs.

I have yet to see the very same people ever not accept a plaster cast for a broken arm. Hypocrites – isn't a broken mind far more serious?

We don't think twice about hiring a plumber, a mechanic, an electrician or any other expert in their field for fixing something that is out of our league yet our bodies which are so much more important are left to chance. To these people who refuse medical help why don't you have the same faith that God will fix your car, or plumbing problems and so on without seeking help elsewhere?

There is no conflict between faith and seeking medical help. Doctors can not do what Jesus does. Only Jesus can heal. Doctors can help the healing process, give medication to help, take out and even replace something and offer a wide range of assistance but they can not actually heal – only Jesus can do that.

There is nothing Jesus can't heal therefore he can heal my sickness



Matthew 4:23-24

And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease** among the people. And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with **divers diseases and torments**, and those which were **possessed with devils**, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the **palsy; and he healed them.**

What Can Jesus Heal?

1. All manner of sickness
2. All manner of diseases

Who Can Jesus heal?

1. Sick people
2. Those who have diseases
3. Those who are possessed of the devil
4. The lunatics – therefore the insane
5. The paralyzed
6. The disabled
7. He healed them ALL - Everyone
8. YOU!!!!!!

Affirmations



- ❖ I can be healed by Jesus Christ
- ❖ Jesus Christ heals all manner of sickness and disease he can certainly heal me of my sickness
- ❖ There is nothing Jesus Christ can not heal therefore he can heal my sickness
- ❖ If I am disabled or paralyzed Jesus can heal me
- ❖ If I am suffering mental affliction or depression Jesus can heal me
- ❖ Jesus healed them all. I am no better or worse then those people so he will also heal me.

Jesus is still healing people today...

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, **and to day**, and for ever.



I will confess with my mouth that Jesus can heal me

Matthew 8:1-3

When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him. And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, **Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.** And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, **I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.**

What can we learn from the leper?

1. He knew that despite having an incurable disease Jesus could still heal him
2. He followed Jesus
3. He worshipped Jesus
4. He asked Jesus
5. He affirmed that Jesus could heal him

What about Jesus response?

1. It is Jesus will to heal us
2. Jesus touched him and spoke the word (affirmed the healing)
3. The leper was immediately healed

Affirmations



- ❖ I know that if it is Jesus will he can heal me
- ❖ I know that it is Jesus will to heal me
- ❖ I know that there is no such thing as an incurable disease for Jesus
- ❖ Jesus can heal me immediately
- ❖ Jesus is the one who can heal me so I will follow Jesus
- ❖ I will worship Jesus
- ❖ I will ask Jesus to heal me
- ❖ I will affirm that Jesus can heal me.

As I believe so shall it be done to me



Matthew 8:5- 13

And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, **beseeching** him, And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. And Jesus saith unto him, **I will come and heal him.** The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but **speak the word only**, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and **as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.** And **his servant was healed** in the selfsame hour.

Some points from this remarkable story

1. The centurion came before Jesus and beseeched – asked for help, pleaded
2. He was coming before Jesus on the behalf of someone else to be healed
3. Jesus response – I will come and heal him – once again it is Jesus desire to heal us
4. The centurion knew the authority and power of Jesus spoken word
5. As you have believed so be it done to you
6. The servant was healed the selfsame hour

Affirmations



- ❖ I will plead with Jesus for him to heal me
- ❖ I will ask Jesus for help
- ❖ Others can pray for me to be healed
- ❖ I can pray for others to be healed
- ❖ It is Jesus desire to come and heal me
- ❖ I know Jesus can heal me
- ❖ All it takes is for Jesus to speak the word and I will be healed
- ❖ As I believe so shall it be done to me



To get a touch from the Lord is so real



Matthew 8:14-17

And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. And **he touched her** hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits **with his word**, and **healed all** that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

How did he heal Peter's mother in law?

He touched her. Once again demonstrating the power of touch / laying on of hands. We sing a chorus that says: To get a touch from the Lord is so real.

How did he cast out the spirits?

With his word... Once again we read where the word of God has the authority to heal.

How many did he heal?

All. Do you think these people were any better or worse than you? Of course not. We read in the scriptures that God is no respecter of persons. By healing them he is openly showing that he can heal you also.

Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses

The NLT says: This fulfilled the word of the Lord through Isaiah, who said, "He **took** our sicknesses and **removed** our diseases.

Affirmations



- ❖ To get a touch from the Lord is so real
- ❖ The word of God will heal me
- ❖ Jesus Christ will heal me
- ❖ Jesus wants to take my sickness
- ❖ Jesus wants to remove my diseases



I will be of good cheer while waiting for Jesus to heal me



Matthew 9:1-8

And he entered into a ship, and passed over, and came into his own city. And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and **Jesus seeing their faith** said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, **be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.** And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This man blasphemeth. And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, Wherefore think ye evil in your hearts? For whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk. But **that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins,** (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. **And he arose,** and departed to his house. But when the multitudes saw it, they marvelled, and **glorified God,** which had **given such power** unto men.

Question:

What is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk?

It's ludicrous isn't it? They were accusing him off blasphemy because he said to this man his sins were forgiven. But as Jesus said, what is easier to say? Both are amazing!

Today things have switched around somewhat.... We have millions of Christians who believe without a shadow of a doubt that God forgives them yet don't believe they can be healed.

Same question applies: What is easier? **If you can be forgiven, you also can be healed.**

Some other interesting points

1. Jesus seeing THEIR faith
2. Be of good cheer
3. Your sins are forgiven thee
4. Jesus has power to heal and to forgive
5. Healing brings glory to God

Affirmations



- ❖ I will ask Jesus for healing and I will ask my friends, my brothers and sisters, and my Church to also ask on my behalf
- ❖ I will be of good cheer while waiting for Jesus to heal me
- ❖ Jesus forgives my sins as well as healing me
- ❖ My healing will bring glory to God



If I can just touch the hem of his garment



Matthew 9:18-25

While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and **worshipped him**, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come **and lay thy hand upon her**, and she shall live. And Jesus arose, and followed him, and so did his disciples. And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and **touched the hem of his garment: For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole**. But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, **be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole**. And the woman was **made whole** from that hour. And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise, He said unto them, **Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth**. And they laughed him to scorn. But when the people were put forth, he went in, and **took her by the hand, and the maid arose**.

The ruler

1. Came to Jesus
2. Worshipped Jesus
3. His daughter was dead but he knew she still could be healed
4. He knew how effective laying on of hands is
5. He had to wait on the healing while other miracles were happening around him
6. Jesus considers death as just a sleep
7. Jesus raised her from the dead

The woman with the issue of blood

1. Also came to Jesus
2. Made an affirmation – If I may just touch the hem of his garment I shall be whole
3. Put faith into action. She followed after him and pressed forward to touch the hem
4. Be of good comfort
5. Her faith has made her whole

Affirmations



- ❖ I will go to Jesus for my healing needs
- ❖ I will worship Jesus
- ❖ I will ask Jesus to heal me
- ❖ Jesus can even raise the dead he can surely heal my sickness
- ❖ I will ask for the laying of hands
- ❖ I will persevere and wait for my healing
- ❖ I will reach out to Jesus
- ❖ I will touch the hem of Jesus garment and be healed
- ❖ I will be of good comfort while waiting for my healing
- ❖ My faith in Jesus will make me whole



I believe Jesus is able to do this thing



Matthew 9:27-30

And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, **have mercy on us**. And when he was come into the house, **the blind men came to him**: and Jesus saith unto them, **Believe ye that I am able to do this?** They said unto him, **Yea, Lord**. Then **touched** he their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you**. And **their eyes were opened**.

Interesting Points

1. Jesus had mercy on them
2. The blind men came to him
3. Jesus said: Believe that I am able to do this thing
4. Not only did they say – Yes. They called him Lord
5. He touched them
6. According to your faith be it unto you
7. They were healed

Affirmations



- ❖ I know Jesus will have mercy on me
- ❖ I will come to Jesus
- ❖ I believe Jesus is able to this thing and heal me
- ❖ Jesus is my Lord
- ❖ According to my faith will it be done to me



I will teach and preach the gospel and healings will follow



Matthew 9:32-36

As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils. And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues, and **preaching the gospel of the kingdom**, and **healing every sickness** and **every disease** among the people. But when he saw the multitudes, he was **moved with compassion on them**, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

Comments

1. Jesus healed every sickness and every disease
2. Nothing is impossible for Jesus
3. Healing follows teaching and preaching the gospel
4. Jesus has compassion for us
5. There are always those who cast aspersions about the healings and a lot of the time the accusers are religious people

Affirmations



- ❖ There is nothing Jesus can not heal so he can heal me
- ❖ I will teach and preach the gospel and healings will follow
- ❖ Jesus has compassion on me
- ❖ I will not allow the doubters or accusers to turn me away from Jesus the great healer

By his stripes I am healed



1 Peter 2:24

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.**

Comments:

The concordance provides other meanings for stripes such as: a **bruise**, wale, wound that trickles with blood. While healed means **to be made whole**. (We are made complete in Jesus).

Does the following passage of scripture give you just some idea how much the Lord desires you to be healed?

Mark 15:15-20

And so Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had **scourged him**, to be crucified. And the soldiers led him away into the hall, called Praetorium; and they call together the whole band. And they clothed him with purple, and **platted a crown of thorns**, and **put it about his head**, And began to salute him, Hail, King of the Jews! And **they smote him on the head with a reed**, and did **spit upon him**, and bowing their knees worshipped him. And when they had **mocked him**, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to **crucify** him.

When Jesus was 'scourged' it means whipped.

The scourge (called the flagrum or flagellum) was a short whip consisting of three leather thongs on which were attached small pieces of metal or sharp bone. Scourging quickly remove the skin off and resulted in the back being ripped to the bone.

By whose stripes (bruises) we were healed:

1. By whose stripes we were healed (past tense – already happened)
2. A crown of sharp pointy painful thorns was put on his
3. They took it in turns to strike him over the head with a reed
4. They spat on him
5. They mocked him
6. They crucified him

Why am I dwelling on this so much?

I want you to imagine as best you can what it was like for the Lord. Can you imagine being hit just once with a whip consisting of 3 leather thongs full of metal or bones to **rip your skin off**? Then try to imagine it happening **to you over and over and over again**.

Can you imagine your **blood raw back stripped of skin** having a purple robe placed on it? Can you imagine the pain that would cause?

Now imagine the pain of that robe being taken off again **after the blood has stuck it**. This is torture we are talking about here.

Now imagine **sharp thorns** being placed into your head. Have you ever pricked your hand on a thorn? It hurts doesn't it? **Now imagine that pain** as an entire crown of thorns is forced down upon your head.

Then they struck him over the head with a reed (a rod made out of reed). Can you imagine the pain that you would already be in from all of the other things already mentioned and now being hit (and it means with force they weren't gentle little taps) over the head with rods?

How many times could you withstand being hit over the head with rods? It says the whole band (the tenth part of legion – about 600 men) – how many took it in turns to hit him?

Then they spat on him – how gross is that?

They continually mocked him and of course he was eventually crucified after being paraded for everyone to see on the way to Calvary.

By whose stripes you ARE healed!

Isaiah 53:3-4

Surely he hath **borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows**: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But **he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

So once again why am I laboring these points?

Have you or someone else you know ever been sick or have experience any other problem and just said – **‘It is my cross to bear’**

Who has borne our griefs?

Who has carried our sorrows?

Who was stricken?

Who was smitten of God?

Who was afflicted?

Who was wounded for our transgressions?

Who was bruised for our iniquities?

Who took our chastisement upon himself?

Jesus of course... It is NOT our cross to bear

He has borne the cross for us.

I want you to contemplate and to picture all of the pain and suffering Jesus went through and when you can see it vividly in your mind come to the realization that - **With HIS stripes we ARE healed.**

Affirmations



- ❖ Jesus himself has borne my sins in his own body on the cross
- ❖ I am now dead to sins
- ❖ I am now alive to righteousness
- ❖ By Jesus stripes I was healed
- ❖ Jesus has borne all of my grief
- ❖ Jesus has carried my sorrows
- ❖ Jesus was stricken on my behalf
- ❖ Jesus was smitten for me
- ❖ Jesus took on himself my affliction
- ❖ Jesus was wounded for my transgressions
- ❖ Jesus was bruised for my iniquities
- ❖ Jesus took my chastisement upon himself
- ❖ Jesus skin was ripped off his back for my healing
- ❖ Jesus was bruised for my healing
- ❖ With Jesus stripes I am healed



I see with my eyes



Matthew 13:15-16

For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and **I should heal them**. But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear.

What can hinder healing?

If my heart is waxed gross (hardened, dull)
If my ears are dull of hearing
If my eyes have closed

What can assist in healing?

If I see with my eyes
If I hear with my ears
If I understand with my heart
If I am converted

I particularly like the statement that we should **understand with our heart**.

Proverbs 3:5

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and **lean not unto thine own understanding**.

Trust the Lord with your heart. Our minds can not comprehend the impossible however in the Lord all things are possible. Bypass the natural mind and understand with your heart.

Affirmations



- ❖ Blessed are my eyes for they see
- ❖ Blessed are my ears for they hear
- ❖ I understand with my heart
- ❖ I do not lean to my own understanding
- ❖ I have been converted so now Jesus can heal me
- ❖ I trust in the Lord with all my heart

I will come to Jesus by any means possible

Matthew 13:15-16

And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive them, no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them. And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four. And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay. When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee...

Verses 11-12:

I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house. And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and glorified God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion.

Do we allow our busy schedules to keep us away from Jesus?

In all the accounts of people being healed by Jesus they (or someone on their behalf) came to Jesus. This guy had 4 other people carry him to Jesus and when they got there they still couldn't reach him for the crowd so they ripped the roof off and lowered him down.

They knew the importance of getting to Jesus. He is the one that has the solution to our problems so why do we allow ourselves to be so easily turned away from him by obstacles we meet in our day to day life?

Have you prayed today?

If not why?

Is it because your life is too crowded and you couldn't find time? What if these guys turned away because of the crowd? The poor guy would never have been healed.

What is stopping you from going to Church regularly?

What is stopping you from reading the Bible regularly?

What is stopping you from preaching the gospel regularly?

Get through the crowd and rip the roof off if you have to but whatever you do you must get to Jesus.

The importance of friends (brothers and sisters in the Lord)

Most of us have had the misfortune of being very ill at some stage in our life. When you are sick you don't exactly feel like praying, etc. – all you want to do is lay in bed and sleep. This is where we need the support of our friends.

These guys literally carried their friend to Jesus however we can carry our brothers and sisters to the Lord as well in our prayers. It is so important that we pray for each other. Sometimes we lack the ability to do things on our own.

Do you know someone that needs healing?

Have you prayed for them?

Did you pray for them just once?

Or do you continually pray for them? The guys who carried the sick of palsy didn't just carry him for one block. **They carried him all the way** Jesus.

Have you gathered others and prayed for healing need together? The Lord said in Matthew 18:19-20 - Where 2 or 3 are gathered together there I am in the midst of them. And also that **if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, *it shall be done*** for them of my Father which is in heaven.



I will hang out where the power of God is



Luke 5:17

And it came to pass on a certain day, **as he was teaching**, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and **the power of the Lord was present to heal them.**

The power of the Lord was present to heal them.

So if we want healing doesn't it seem obvious that we should hang around the places where the power of the Lord is present?

The power of the Lord is present **where the word is taught or preached.**

Affirmations



- ❖ I will not allow any obstacles to get in between myself and Jesus
- ❖ I will come to Jesus
- ❖ Jesus has the solutions to my problems
- ❖ I will pray today
- ❖ I will pray for others today
- ❖ I will pray for serious needs with others
- ❖ I will ask my friends to pray for me when I need help
- ❖ I will go the extra mile for brothers and sisters
- ❖ I will go where the power of God
- ❖ I will attend Church meetings
- ❖ I will preach and teach the word to others
- ❖ I will go listen to the word of God



Don't be afraid just believe

Mark 5:35-42

While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue's house certain which said, Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further? As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, **Be not afraid, only believe.** And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James.

And he cometh to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept and wailed greatly. And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth. And **they laughed him to scorn.**

But **when he had put them all out,** he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying. And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise. And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was of the age of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment.

A few things to note here:

This person had died. You can't get any sicker then that can you? No matter what disease you have Jesus can heal you.

Jesus said, "Be not afraid, only believe." Let me point out here once and for all you don't have to be super spiritual or come up with some secret formula. All you need to do is **ONLY believe.** In other words just trust the Lord.

They laughed him to scorn. Be prepared – people will laugh at you and mock you for your belief.

Jesus also put out the unbelievers. Skeptics always complain there is no proof of miracles because they never happen before their eyes. That is because miracles are for believers ONLY.

We need to put out the unbelief from ourselves as well and that comes by sowing the word of God into our life. Read the word, listen to the word and live the word.

Affirmations



- ❖ I will not be afraid of the situation I am in
- ❖ I will do one thing only and that is believe
- ❖ I trust in the Lord
- ❖ It is never too late for Jesus to heal me
- ❖ I will not allow the mocking of others sway my belief
- ❖ I will put out unbelief from my life



He sent his word and healed them



Psalm 107:20

He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

How powerful is Gods word?

And of course his word was made flesh – so how powerful is Jesus Christ?

He sent his word – he also sent Jesus – so we can be healed.

I have experienced personally, and have heard very similar testimonies of others being healed of depression by combating the hurtful thoughts with the word of God.

You see one of the phases of depression is that because your serotonin levels drop your brain seeks out all of the most painful memories of your life and replays them like a video. During this phase your mind speeds up and plays these hurtful thoughts and images over and over again.

Every micro second of every second of every minute of every hour of every day these hurtful thoughts and images play over and over again. It is like being stabbed in the heart every second. It is torture of the mind.

To cut a long story short when this was happening to me I truly grabbed hold of the scripture that says – Lean not to thine own understanding.

I knew my thinking was wrong and the only source that was right was the Bible. So I combated the bad thoughts with the good thoughts of the Bible. I took every scripture I could find about the love of God and forgiveness and meditated upon them, prayed over them and sang about them.

Slowly and little by little the good thoughts started to win out and the depression began to lift. **Healed by the word of God.**

Like I said before, I have since heard other testimonies very similar to this where the word of God was used to get rid of bad thoughts and heal depression.

The word of God **IS** powerful and God has given it to us so we can be healed.

We reap what we sow and if we want the good things that the word of God can provide then we need to sow it into our life.
