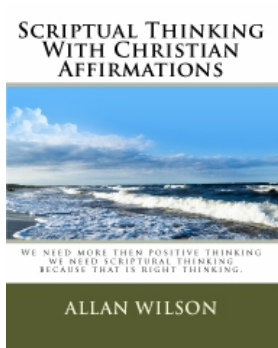

**John 15:13-14**

*Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. **Ye** are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.*

YOU – Yes YOU – Insert YOUR NAME into this scripture. **YOU are Jesus Christ's friend.**

One on one... Not someone else. Take it on board for yourself – **this is personal.**

How often do we hear someone get up and testify that they now have **a personal relationship with Jesus Christ?**

This is personal...

The scriptures are for us... As we read these scriptures we as individuals are friends of the Lord. Sometimes we read the scriptures and we look at things and we put it into this broad basket or category.

However today I don't want you to do that I want you to go in and apply them to you as an individual.

So let's read the scripture again with **YOUR NAME** inserted. When reading the scriptures throughout this book where you see **YOUR NAME** read allowed your First and Last **Name in this spot**.

**John 15:13-14**

*Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. **YOUR NAME you are my friend**, if ye do whatsoever I command you.*



I don't know about you but I get goose bumps from reading someone else's name in there as well. Rather than just mine. I mean it's a real blast having my name in there.

Allan Wilson a friend of Jesus Christ... However I get just as big a blessing and a kick out of it by just reading someone else's name in there as well.

And every person who is spirit filled – these are your blessings.

It goes on in...

**John 15:15**

*Henceforth I call **YOUR NAME** not a servant; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called **YOUR NAME** my friend; for **all things that I have heard** of my Father **I have made known** unto **YOUR NAME**.*



Wow what a blessing!

Jesus has called **YOUR NAME** his friend.

For all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto **YOUR NAME**, or to whoever is born again. Your name... you are not a servant anymore... you are a part of the action.

Then it continues in...

**John 15:16**

**YOUR NAME** has not chosen me, but **I have chosen** **YOUR NAME**, and **ordained** **YOUR NAME**, that **YOUR NAME** should go and bring forth fruit, and that **YOUR NAME'S** fruit should remain: that whatsoever **YOUR NAME** shall ask of the Father in my name, he may **give it** to **YOUR NAME**.



Hallelujah!

Read that last verse again with your name in it. When you're down in your prayer, when you are seeking the Lord... this is faith building stuff folks, put it to the Lord... it's exciting...

He has ordained you... **YOU**... Personally!!

Sure when we come together as a group it's great but this is personal. This is one on one stuff. He has ordained you, and for a reason – that you should **bring forth fruit** and that **your fruit should remain**.

And **whatever you shall ask** of the Father he shall give it to you. What a wonderful blessing from God. What a wonderful personal relationship we have with God.

Let's look at some personal scriptures of what Jesus Christ has done for us as individuals.

**1 Peter 2:24**

Who Himself bore **YOUR NAME's** sins in His own body on the tree, that **YOUR NAME**, having died to sins, might live for righteousness--by whose stripes **YOUR NAME** was healed.



Put your name in there folks. Put your name in there... Who in is own self bore YOUR sins. Isn't it great to see what God has done for us as individuals and for our brothers and sisters?

He has bore **YOUR** sins in His own body on the tree. So that **YOU** being dead unto sin should live unto righteousness and by whose stripes **YOU** is healed.

Hallelujah... This is great stuff for us to take hold of.

**Isaiah 53:4-5**

Surely he hath **borne** **YOUR NAME's** griefs, and **carried** **YOUR NAME's** sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was **wounded** for **YOUR NAME's** transgressions, he was **bruised** for **YOUR NAME's** iniquities: the chastisement of **YOUR NAME's** peace was upon him; and with his **stripes** **YOUR NAME** is healed.



Put your name in there folks. Put your name in there... he was wounded for your transgressions. One on one...

For **YOUR** transgressions, he was bruised for **YOUR** iniquities, sins and weaknesses. This is personal stuff... he was bruised for all of **YOUR** weaknesses, **YOUR** inadequacies... the chastisement of **YOUR** peace was upon him.

Individual stuff... **they were put on him.**

Once again it says that by his stripes **YOU** are healed.

Victory in Jesus Christ -- for you the individual... When we come to the Lord the first things that happened to us was one on one stuff.

We had to repent as individuals. Mum and dad couldn't do it for us... our spouse couldn't do it for us... No body else could do it for us it had to be personal.

Individual stuff... we had to repent. We personally had to be baptised. We personally... one on one with God... received the Holy Ghost the fire.

It's always personal. It's always one on one. I can sit here and I can rejoice from hearing testimonies, I can rejoice by hearing how someone else has been blessed by God but at the end of the day **we don't have to depend on someone else's say so.**

We don't have to depend on someone else's faith. We don't have to depend on someone else's experience **because we have it** personally ourselves. One on one with the Lord.

This is a wonderful position we have been placed in. Jesus is our Saviour...

When we get down and we pray in our prayer times it is one on one in our closets. Remember who we are praying to... We are praying to the one who was bruised for us as individuals. We are praying to the one who was wounded for our transgressions.

I am praying to Jesus who was wounded for my sins. No one else's! Sure it happened for everyone else but when I'm praying Jesus is **my personal saviour – He died for my sins.**

**Romans 5:1-2**

Therefore being justified by faith, **YOUR NAME** has **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ:



Now in the New Testament through grace **YOU have peace with God** through our Lord.

See how it happens?

We now have peace. You know we don't have to wait to die... **we can rest in peace now.** Don't we?

Rest in peace... we don't have to strive, we don't have to battle, we don't have to struggle because we have peace between us and God. Peace with God! Through our Lord Jesus Christ.

By whom also **YOUR NAME has access** by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.



Access!

Meditate on these things. These are just some scriptures. You can go through every scripture in the Bible where it says you, ye, we, thou and put your name there and apply it to yourself.

What we are covering here in the small ebook is just a drop in the bucket. It's just a sample of how we can **take the scriptures personally**.

Sometimes we can read the 'we's and the ye's' and see it as a collective and don't apply it to ourselves enough. I really want us to apply the word of God to ourselves.

It's not about being selfish...

If we want to serve others we ourselves must be edified. We must be built up in the faith. We must be applying these things to ourselves.

Because if everyone of us as individuals are walking one on one with a personal relationship with the Lord then when we do come together... combined... it's even better.

**We must apply it as individuals.**

Wonderful, fabulous blessings to each and every one of us. And we have access. When we have been born again we have access to this faith.

Isn't that absolutely incredible?

We have access to it... It's not something that is afar of and a long way away. We can tap into it.

**Romans 5:8-11**

But God commendeth his love toward **YOUR NAME**, in that, while **YOUR NAME** was yet a sinner, Christ died for **YOUR NAME**. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, **YOUR NAME** shall be saved from wrath through him.



For if, when **YOUR NAME** was an enemy, **YOUR NAME** was reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, **YOUR NAME** shall be saved by his life. And not only so, but **YOUR NAME** also joys in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom **YOUR NAME** has now received the atonement.

It can be a bit hard trying to deliver the goods using **YOUR NAME** and it would be excellent if you all could just see your own names in the above scriptures.

I hope you are really enjoying seeing the statements in the word of God concerning you as an individual.

**Engrave your name into these scriptures.**

Sometimes we think we're not good enough and this and that and all the other stuff. Well if he was willing to die for us... if he was willing to go that far for us while we were the worst we could possibly be how much more is he going to do for us now?

How much more?

We will be saved from the wrath to come through him. We shall be saved by his life. Not only so but we also **joy** in God through our Lord Jesus Christ by whom we have now received the atonement.

**NOW** it says...

We have received the atonement **now**... as individuals... one on one stuff.

**1 Corinthians 6:11**

*And such were some of you: but **YOUR NAME** is washed, but **YOUR NAME** is sanctified, but **YOUR NAME** is justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.*



Put your name in there folks.

You're **washed**... you're **sanctified**... you're **justified!**

There is a lot in just that one verse of scripture. Washed, sanctified and justified. In the name of the Lord Jesus...

...and How?

**By the Spirit of God.**

That's how we got washed. That's how we got sanctified. That's how we got justified. Through the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of God. Our wonderful salvation message brings so much into our lives...

**2 Corinthians 5:17-21**

Therefore if **YOUR NAME** be in Christ, **YOUR NAME** is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled **YOUR NAME** to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to **YOUR NAME** the ministry of reconciliation;



Are you reading your name in that scripture?

**You are a new creature.** Yes you... individually. A new creature... old things are gone and all things have become new.

It doesn't get boring in the Lord.

All things have become new. Think of what new means... **Fresh!**

And he has given to you the ministry of reconciliation. How exciting is it to be able to **reconcile people back to God?**

That's your ministry. Is there any other calling that could be better than reconciling people back to God?

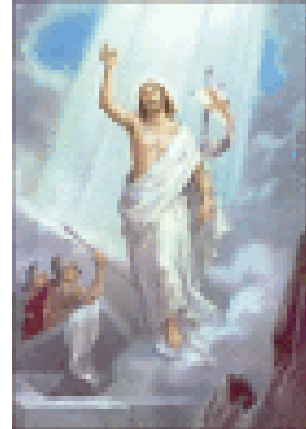
Even in your own families there are black sheep and so on. Someone has had a falling out and brother fights brother or sister fights sister, or whatever. Isn't it good when you can play a role in reconciling people? That's just an example in the flesh – doesn't it feel good when you have been able to help out in the reconciling of warring parties?

**John 14:1-3**

Let not **YOUR NAME's** heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.



Let's just pause and put your name in there...

Jesus is going so he can prepare a place for... who?

You...

Don't let your heart be troubled there is a place being prepared for you. What a privilege that Jesus is preparing a place for us... as individuals.

And if I go and prepare a place for **YOUR NAME**, I will come again, and receive **YOUR NAME** unto myself; that where I am, there **YOUR NAME** may be also.



Put your name in there.

### **It's talking to you.**

Your name through the Holy Spirit, through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ... Our name is written in the book of life. Put your name in it when you're reading the scriptures. Put your brothers and sisters name in there when you're reading the Bible.

Esteem them highly.

**John 14:12-14**

Verily, verily, I say unto you, **YOUR NAME** believeth on me, the works that I do shall **YOUR NAME** do also; and greater works than these shall **YOUR NAME** do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever **YOUR NAME** shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If **YOUR NAME** shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.



Once again insert your name in there...

If you believe on Jesus then the works that he did **you shall do also** and **greater** works. That is what it says. The reason why is not because we are so special it is because we believe on Jesus and it is he who is doing the work because he has risen to be with the Father now.

**Believe** on him.

Believe in these scriptures. Sometimes it can be hard when we look around and see that things aren't happening perhaps. This person hasn't been healed, that person hasn't been healed, I'm still as mental as I've always been and I've got a broken foot... whatever.

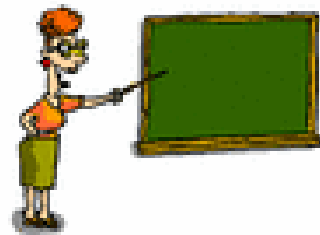

He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto **YOUR NAME**.*

He will **show you** things to come.

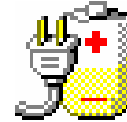
He will **guide you** into all truth.

The Holy Spirit shall glorify Jesus and **show it unto you**. No wonder the scriptures say blessed are your eyes for you see...

**2 Timothy 1:7**

For God hath not given **YOUR NAME** the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.



Put your name in there.

What's he given you?

A sound mind. Power and love. It's all there for you.

**2 Timothy 1:9**

Who hath saved **YOUR NAME**, and called **YOUR NAME** with an holy calling, not according to **YOUR NAME's** works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given to **YOUR NAME** in Christ Jesus before the world began,

You can see then how it really clears it up that **you can not earn it**. You can't earn it – it's not by your works. It's not by being a Holy Joe, it's not by doing all of these things – it is given to us according to his purpose.

It is of grace and it is a Holy calling...

**James 1:2-5**

**YOUR NAME**, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;



Yahoo... Are you counting it all joy when you are going through a hard time?

Knowing this, that the trying of **YOUR NAME's** faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that **YOUR NAME** may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.



How's that?

**Ask** God!

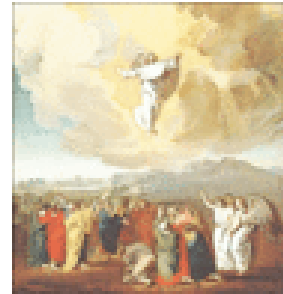
He doesn't go crook on you (upbraideth not).
